

GP Quality Checking – Beechwood Medical Centre

The information below is a short, easy-read list of things the checkers found at the surgery.

	<p>Is there disabled parking at the surgery?</p>	<p>Yes. There is disabled parking at the entrance to the surgery.</p>
	<p>Is it easy to get into the surgery waiting room (even if you find it difficult to walk or use a wheelchair)?</p>	<p>The 1st door opens itself as you walk up to it. The 2nd door opens by using a push-pad.</p>
	<p>Does the surgery have a person that patients with a learning disability can speak to?</p>	<p>Yes, all staff are trained and know how to support their patients who have a learning disability.</p> <p>Dr King is also the lead doctor for patients with a learning disability.</p>
	<p>Does the GP give patients information in easy-read?</p>	<p>No, but the GP will make sure that the patient fully understands all the information they have been given.</p>
	<p>Can you book a double appointment?</p>	<p>Yes, the patient can ask for a double appointment when they ring the surgery.</p>
	<p>Does the surgery offer Annual Health Checks?</p>	<p>Yes. The surgery will ring the patient and remind them the day before their appointment.</p> <p>Patients with a learning disability are given a named member of staff when they join the surgery so they will always be able to speak to the same person when they ring or visit the surgery.</p>
