

GP Quality Checking – Boulevard Surgery, Savile Park

The information below is a short, easy-read list of things the checkers found at the surgery.

	Is there disabled parking at the surgery?	Yes, there are disabled parking spaces at the entrance to the surgery.
	Is it easy to get into the surgery waiting room (even if you find it difficult to walk or use a wheelchair)?	Yes, all the doors open by themselves as you walk up to them.
	Does the surgery have a person that patients with a learning disability can speak to?	All the staff at the surgery can offer help to any patient that comes into the surgery.
	Does the GP give patients information in easy-read?	Yes, the doctor can give you information in easy-read.
	Can you book a double appointment?	Yes, the patient can ask for a double appointment when they ring the surgery.
	Does the surgery offer Annual Health Checks?	Yes, patients are written to, if the surgery does not hear from the patient they will contact them again. A member of staff can come into your appointment too if needed – this is called a chaperone.
